 messuage or dwelling house with appurtenances belonging thereto and 1. 2. 20
 of land more or less being at Sluomington in the County of Hereford and
 now in the tenure of Ercupston I also give and bequeath unto my daughter a
 Mary Priore of Acre and assigns for ever all that messuage or dwelling
 house and appurtenances thereto belonging with outland garden topers or
 gates stoves pump fixtures &c being at Brampton in the County of Rutland
 and now in the tenure of Ercupston I also give and bequeath unto my
 daughter Mary Priore of Acre and assigns for ever all that dwelling house
 with stables drying house tan yard and other appurtenances being at Norroth
 in the County of Rutland and also five lands being in the open fields of Norroth
 and belonging to the said estate I also give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Mary Priore a note or bond from Dixon of Corby in the County of Northampton
 being for the sum of three hundred and twelve pounds and after the death of
 my brother in law Augustin Priore of Wing in the County of Rutland I
 give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Priore of Acre and assigns
 for ever all those two messuages or dwelling houses with outland garden and
 other appurtenances belonging thereto being at South Suffieldam and now in
 the tenure of occupation of John Cobley and Edmund Darsfield I also give and
 bequeath unto my daughter Mary Priore of Acre and assigns for ever
 all my share being one third part of an estate at Harwell in the County of
 Northampton consisting of a house close garden and other appurtenances
 belonging thereto and now in the tenure of Stafford Bottrill Esq. after
 the death of my brother in law Augustin Priore of Wing in the County
 of Rutland I will and bequeath unto my son Augustin Priore of Acre and
 assigns for ever all those four lands in the bottom field of South Suffieldam a
 near the Mill Back containing 1. 2. 35 more or less I will and bequeath unto
 my son Thomas Priore after all my just debts are discharged funeral expenses
 and the charges of proving and executing this my will and on condition that

 one half part or share of the live and dead stock standing in the name of

 standing implecments of husbandry and all other effects whatsoever wheresoever
 and of what kind soever and I will and bequeath unto my son James Pridmore

 of the estates at about a Suffieldham or elsewhere not heretofore devised. In

 or sums of money as now are or hereafter may be due to me for my service on board the said ship or any
 other ship or vessel of the Royal Navy and do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Oliver Stedman
 Executor and my sister Barbara Puppelt sole Executors of this my last will and testament that is
 receiving and making void all other and former wills by me heretofore made and do declare this to be my last
 will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of September in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two and in the sixth year of the reign of our
 Sovereign Lady Victoria by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and of Ireland Queen
 Defender of the Faith. *Thos Puppelt* — Signed sealed published and declared by the said Thomas a
 Puppelt as and for his last will and testament in the presence of Doctor William Martin & Dr. J.
 Mollot and Mr. John Russell who have hereunto subscribed their names as witnesses in the presence of

Proved at London 30th Nov^r 1842 before the Worshipful John Daubay Doctor of Laws and surrogate in the
 oath of Barbara Stedman (wife of William Stedman formerly Puppelt) in the will written Puppelt
 the sister one of the executors to whom administration was granted having been first sworn duly to administer
 & power reserved of making the like grant to Oliver Stedman the other Executor whereof shall apply for the same.
