**Fanny Bayly Pennicod**, base born daughter of **Mary Pennicod**, was baptized 13 Jan 1765, at St. Mary and St. Blaise, Boxgrove, Sussex. **Mary Pennicod**, spinster, of Boxgrove, married by license to **Joseph Stamp**, bachelor, of Boxgrove, on 06 Oct 1768. Witnesses: John Fogden and John Tapner  
The surname Bayley/Bayly is common enough in Boxgrove and area to be possibility the surname of the unnamed father of **Fanny Bayly Pennicod**. **Joseph and Mary Stamp** were parents of **Elizabeth Stamp**, baptized 10 Apr 1770 at Boxgrove. **Mary Stamp**, the wife of **Joseph** was buried 05 Jun 1772 at Boxgrove. **Joseph Stamp**, age 33, was buried 01 Jul 1776 at Boxgrove. **Elizabeth Stamp**, buried 10 Mar 1797 at Boxgrove.

**Mary Pennicod** was baptized 04 Mar 1742, the daughter of **Oliver Pennicod** and **Mary Terry** of Boxgrove, who were married 21 Nov 1734 at Boxgrove. **Oliver Pennicod**, innkeeper, was buried 22 Oct 1754, at Boxgrove; and, **Mary Pennicod**, widow, was buried 22 Apr 1769, at Boxgrove. The burial of **Jaspar Terry** 05 Jun 1735, says he was the son of **Thomas Terry** and **Mary**, the new wife of **Oliver Pennicott**. **Jaspar Terry** was baptized 08 Aug 1734, son of **Mary Terry**, widow. **Thomas Terry** and **Mary Edlow** were married 07 Jan 1725 at Boxgrove. Their son, **Thomas Terry**, was baptized 25 Oct 1726, at Boxgrove.

**Oliver Pennicod** and **Mary** also had a daughter, **Elizabeth Pennicod**, baptized 13 Apr 1736, at Boxgrove, who married to **John Fogden**, 27 Apr 1757, at Boxgrove, by license. Witnesses were James Lane and Robert Pots. **John Fogden**, age 72, buried 10 Sep 1778 at Boxgrove. **Elizabeth Fogden**, widow died of cancer, buried 11 Sep 1783 at Boxgrove.

**Oliver Pennicod** and **Mary** also has a son **Oliver Pennicod**, baptized 23 Mar 1738, who married in Yapton to **Mary Winsted**, by License and witnesses were John Fogden and John Mills. They were parents of **Elizabeth**, baptized at Yapton, 14 Feb 1762, **Ann**, baptized at Boxgrove, 17 May 1763, and **Mary**, baptized at Boxgrove 22 Sep 1764. **Oliver Pennicod** was buried 20 Dec 1799 at Boxgrove. **Mary Pennicod**, age 83 years was buried 23 Oct 1821 at Boxgrove.

### **Who was James Turner?**

He lived in Yapton Parish, Sussex

He resided at the Yapton Rectory Manor on or next to lands connected with Staker's Farm.

He lived approximately 1759 to 1848

His occupation was Butcher

His name is mentioned with Richard Turner in the Yapton Rectory Lease deeds.

His name is mentioned with two of his sons James Turner Jr. and John Turner

Thomas Barnard and Sarah Hurd, married 1819, were parents of Edward, James, Thomas, George, and Sarah. In 1841 and 1851 they were a farming family living on a farm named Clayton in Washington Parish, Sussex, near the village of Thakeham.

**Charles Barnard** and **Mary Chatham** were married in Pulborough. Family included sons **Allen** born 1787 and **Thomas** born 1790.

**Allen Barnard**, married to **Harriett Hayler Turner**, was father of **Edward** born 1836

**Thomas Barnard**, married to **Sarah Hurd**, was father of **Sarah** born 1837
