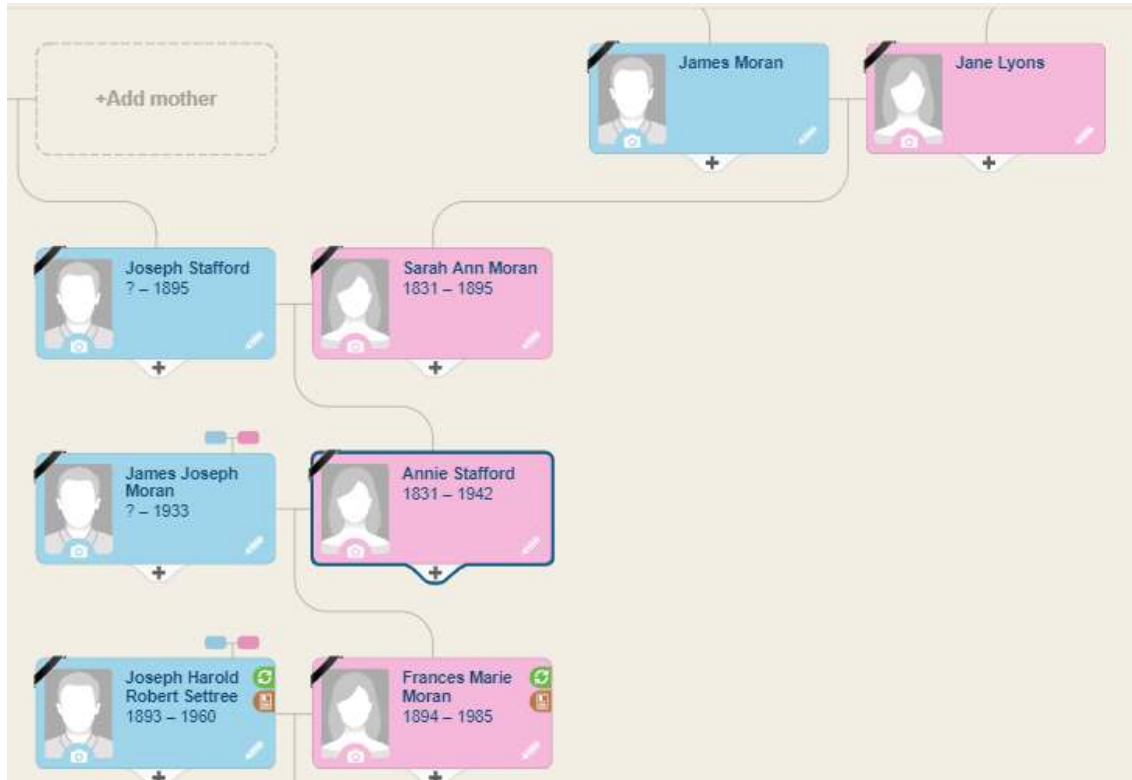


James Joseph Moran (?-1933) and Annie Stafford (1868-1942)

Annie Stafford's Parents


The family tree for Annie Stafford is as follows.

- Annie Stafford married John Joseph Moran in 1891

Sarah was born. This is based on her being 23 when she arrived in Australia in 1854. She may have had a sister Lucy born the year before.
