I Edward Pickford of Glossop in the Parish of Glossop in the County of Derby Intestate being weak in body out of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding prayed be God for the same but considering the frailty of a human life do make and publish and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I own and direct that all my just debts funeral and testamentary Expenses be paid and discharged by my Executors and Administrators hereinafter mentioned and named out of my personal property as soon as convenient after my decease and as to such worldly goods as God of His goodness hath bestowed upon me I give devise and dispose of the same as follows I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann Pittford during her natural life the house in which my daughter Sarah now lives situate being in Glossop aforesaid for her all about day and taxes together with the annual sum of twenty five pounds to be paid her yearly out of my personal property and Estate and I direct and order that one fourth part of the said sum of twenty five pounds as aforesaid be paid her quarterly the first payment to commence and be reckoned from the time of my death I also give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Ann the use of such of my household furniture as may be thought necessary by my Executors to furnish said house during her natural life and at the death of my wife I order and direct that the said house with the premises thereto belonging be sold and the money arising from such sale I order and direct the same to be equally divided amongst my Children share and share alike I also give and bequeath unto my son Abigail Pittford the house in which Betty Bowdrie now lives situate in Glossop aforesaid together with a land sufficient for the keeping & maintaining our cows both summer and winter together with room for the housing of our cows and storing hay for the same the land and buildings to be set out and adjudged by my Executors the paying a proportionate share of Rent Taxes & assessments as my Executors may direct and judge reasonable I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah the wife of Abel a winterbottom the house in which my son Samuel now lives situate in Glossop aforesaid together with land sufficient for the keeping and maintaining our cows both summer & winter together with room for standing of our cows storing hay for the same the land and buildings to be set out and adjudged by my Executors the paying a proportionate share of Rent Taxes & assessments as my Executors may judge reasonable I also give and bequeath unto my son Samuel Pittford the house and premises now occupied together with the interest and benefit of all & every the lease or leases now lived under his Grace the Duke of Norfolk save & except the interest and benefit of the house and lands I have heretofore disposed of the interest and benefit of the house and premises my son Wright now occupies also excepted whose said house & premises I give and bequeath to my daughter Hannah Pittford the paying such share of Rent Taxes and assessments as my Executors may judge equitable and reasonable I also give and bequeath unto my daughter Hannah the whole
