made and duly executed his last Will and Testament (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed)
and did therein name **JOHN FRANCIS DYER** formerly of Mullewa in the said State
but now of 142 Durlacher Street Geraldton aforesaid Agent and Commercial
Traveller sole Executor of his said Will

And be it further known that on the **18th** day of **July** One
thousand nine hundred and forty six Letters of Administration with the said Will
annexed of all and singular the real and personal estate of the said deceased were granted by
the Supreme Court of the said State to the **PUBLIC TRUSTEE** in and for the State of Western
Australia on the Authority of the said **JOHN FRANCIS DYER** the abovenamed Executor
JOHN HAROLD GLYNN
having first sworn that the said **PUBLIC TRUSTEE** would well and faithfully administer
the same.

THIS GRANT is made upon the condition that no portion of
the assets shall be distributed or paid during the war to any
beneficiary or creditor who is an enemy subject wherever resident
or to anyone on his behalf or to or on behalf of any person of
whatever nationality resident in an enemy country or in any
country or territory in the occupation of the enemy without the
express sanction of the Crown and if any distribution or payment
is made contrary to this condition this grant will be forthwith
revoked.

executor and trustee of this my Will and DIRECT that all my
just debts funeral and testamentary expenses be paid as soon as
may be after my decease. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the whole of
my Estate both Real and Personal unto my said Trustee UPON TRUST
to hold the same for the absolute use and benefit of my nephew
ROSS EDGAR of Mullewa aforesaid if and when he shall attain the
age of twentyone years AND in the event of my said nephew failing to
attain that age then UPON TRUST to hold the same for the absolute use
and benefit of JOHN CLIFFORD DYER son of the said John Francis Dyer
of Mullewa aforesaid if and when he shall attain the age of twentyone
years.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have to this my Will set my hand this thirteenth
day of July one thousand nine hundred and thirtyseven.
