

Index of Pyne Trees – Compiled by Jeremy Pyne

Branches of Principle Pynes with Origin in Upton Pyne, Devon.

(Generally applying Upton Pyne Arms of Gules, 3 Pine Apples or between a chevron ermine)

- a) Stawell, Edington and Moorlinch, Somerset – include distinctive names Augustine and Lewis
- b) Axmouth and Lyme Regis – Including Captain Thomas and Hercules
- c) East Down , North Devon – including Pine- Coffins
- d) Bishops Nympton and Ide.
- e) Menzies and Dillman Pyne – Through John Francis and Mary Dillman
- f) Gaynesford and Rivington Pyne – Banking family of New York – including Moses Taylor.
- g) Cork and Ballyvolane certain link but gap in the line – through Henry Pyne of Mogelly, including Sir Richard Pyne , Masters Pynes – younger generations adopted 'Pyne' name through female line.
- h) Dublin and USA – Through Rev Cornelius – includes Glover and Smith Pynes

Pynes of Curry Mallet Somerset

Generally applying arms of Azure, three Mullets Or between Fess Or

- a) Family of Charlton Mackrell, incl Col John Pyne
- b) Family of Captain Valentine and goldsmith Benjamin
- c) Through the latter to gentlemen of Leighton Buzzard and Luton

Devon Families

- a) Ottery St Mary- descendants in Lymstone, Rockbere and Newton Poppleford – stems from John Pyne with land holding in Exminster
- b) Exeter – Several families – initially centres around Heavitree, includes Malachy Pyne
 - a. Sprague Pynes – moved on to Guildford, Portsmouth and Camberwell

- b. Purchase Pynes – On to Kemsing, Pembury and London
- c. Browncey Pynes – Exminster, Battersea and Torquay
- d. Alphington, Bramford Speke – on to Bridgewater, from John b 1805 and Elizabeth Burroughbridge
- e. To Newington and Lambeth – from William b c 1805 and Sarah Rowe
- f. Ide and Rockbere – from Nathaniel d1696, includes Perkins Pynes
- g. Bethnal Green and Shoreditch – from John bc1799 and Jane Britton
- c) Blackawton and Dartmouth – from James and Alice b 1770's, family of stone masons
- d) Willand – later north to Barnsley and Hull , also some in Collumpton from James b c 1720
- e) Topsham – family of Market Gardeners – stems from George m in Silverton and children in Bicton
- f) Sidbury – from William b c1745, later in London and Stonehouse , Plymouth
- g) Berry Narbor and Braunton – wide use of Pine spelling – from John b c 1670 (vicinity of East Down Family.
- h) Littleham, Exmouth and Lympstone – from John bc1730 – family of masons and river pilots – later in London
- i) Honiton on Otter – later to Wandsworth, from Richard bc 1650
- j) Bicton, Aylesbeare and Colaton Raleigh – incl William (base born) m Joan Whie 1783
- k) Broadclyst and Whimble

Somerset Families

- a) Weston in Gordano, Nailsea and on to South London – starts with Joseph Pyne b c1772 – younger branches also in Wales , Sheffield and Barnsley (My Own)
- b) **Wellington** Branches
 - a. Group from John and Rebecka sergemakers, includes John and Mary Hall parents of naval family with Commander Henry Pyne
 - b. Edmund and Sarah Slade – includes family lost at sea – tilemakers of Honiton

- c. Langford Budville – onto Bristol from Lewis
 - d. Paris Pynes – from Abraham and Ann Paris
 - e. John and Joan Lapthorne – some in Taunton and Rockwell Green
 - f. John and Elizabeth Webber, incl John Solicitor of Martock and Bernard Pyne Grenfell
 - g. Collard Pynes, includes Surgeons of Wellington and Joseph John – maker of Photographic apparatus in Manchester
 - h. Robert and Eleanor Slape – move to Taunton and branch to Canada
 - i. Mogford Pynes from Joseph bc 1800 – includes Pyne Bros of Lewisham
- c) Lyng and Stoke St Gregory – from William c1740, use name of Augustine cf family of Stawell
 - d) Oakford and Brushford – employs Pine spelling majority of the time – family includes blacksmiths
 - e) Pawlett from John and Mary Lyde m 1714 – employs Pine spelling, also use of Augustine name.
 - f) Yeovil and Sherbourne (Dorset) – generations of Lionel – likely branch of principle family – starts with Lionel m Joan Thomas 1622
 - g) Taunton – several branches – using the name Edward regularly – several instances in late 17th C
 - h) Milverton – small family group from John and Sarah Davey m 1729
 - i) Bridgwater - from John b c 1675, blacksmith m Hannah at Lyng in 1695 – use Pine spelling largely , includes watch/clockmaker John ch 1742

London

- a) Family of Falkland and Rowland Pynes, group of siblings with unclear origins – possible link to Dublin family
- b) Bow and Bethnal Green – on to Kidderminster and Worcester from Edmund Pyne and Lucy – includes Sir Thomas Salter Pyne
- c) Wandesford – onto Crayford, Kent, Bath and Southwark - Kendrick Pynes and includes Opera Singer Louisa Pyne. Starts with Peter and Phoebe Pyne.
- d) Poplar – from John b c1780, cab drivers – poss from Ireland emigrating to the East end.

- e) Woolwich - from Peter b c 1740, led to significant group of Mariners based in Devonport.

Ireland – Other than branch from principle family at Ballyvolane etc

- a) Dublin – to Duxford Cambs, incl Rev Benjamin Pyne b 1766 and number of Thompson Pynes
- b) Waterford – from farmer Benjamin Pyne – includes Sparke Pynes and branch in Ontario with Robert Allen Pyne and family of William Washington Pyne of Lancing, Sussex.
- c) Cork to Holborn and St Pancras from John bc1833.

Bristol

- a) Principle strand through Bryant Pynes and Henry , merchant and Postmaster – the latter specifically linked as ‘cousin’ of William Pyne of Alphington – on of the Exeter branches – using principle Pyne Arms
- b) Family of George, Shoemaker/cordwainer – descendants in Swansea and Newport
- c) Origin of family through Joseph Pyne glass maker moved to Norway and ancestor of contact Ole Pein

Other Locations;

- a) Cornwall – several families esp in locations Bocconnoc, Lanreath and Duloe – some from John bc1710
- b) Banbury , Chester and Oldham – from Joshua bc 1751 something of an outlier and could be independent occurrence
- c) Nottingham and Leicester – largely from Thomas of Dorchester, Dorset and Wooton Glanville – poss link through line of Lionels in Yeovil
