## Plea

To

Department L. 27124

Luftgau – Postoffice – Königsberg.

I request the transfer of my son, private first class Hans Schindler, into the department of the Luftgaukommandos VIII command of airport department 2/VIII, Breslau, Kurfrstenstraße 3-7, due to the following reasons:

I'm owner of a grocery in Brockau near Breslau and I require the help of my son urgently. If he could be, transferred to Breslau or in vicinity, this would help me vastly. He could help me in the evening or Sundays. Because i only have one employee provided, and I won't get another one assigned anytime soon from the employment office.

Because of the hero's death of my youngest son on the east front, my wife, who was upto that point of great support with the grocery shop, is now metally broken and she can barely help me at the grocery shop any more. Since i personally don't feel very well for years and I'm often visiting the doctor, my son could, if he would be transferred to Breslau, help me out a lot after work. This would prohibit , if my health deteriorates more, the enforced closure of my nutrient important shop.

As I found out, the command of airport department 2/VIII, is willing to provide an alternate. In hope, that my plea is granted, I sign with
