

**NEW SOUTH WALES.**

CERTIFICATE TO NATURALIZE, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF  
 THE ACTS OF THE GOVERNOR AND COUNCIL, XI VICTORIA,  
 No. 39. and 17<sup>th</sup> Victoria No 8. *Jacob Pepp.*

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of an Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of New South Wales, passed in the Eleventh year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled, "An Act to amend the laws relating to Aliens within the Colony of New South Wales," and of another Act of the said Governor and Legislative Council passed in the thirteenth year of the Reign of Her said Majesty intituled, "An Act to amend the Act relating to the settlement of Aliens in the Colony of New South Wales,"

has presented to me a Memorial, in the form and manner prescribed by the said <sup>first</sup> recited Act, praying that he may be naturalized; And Whereas, I have enquired into the truth of the circumstances set forth in the said Memorial, I the Governor aforesaid do hereby Certify that it has been established to my satisfaction that the said Jacob App is a native of Saferthal, Ladenburg Thirty seven years of age, and that having arrived by the Ship 'Victoria' in the year 1854 he is now residing in at Albany and wishing to purchase land in the said colony for the purpose of cultivation

\_\_\_\_\_ he desires to obtain the advantages of the said Act, and I do therefore grant to the said *Joseph Parn* (upon his taking before one of the Judges of the Supreme Court, the Oath prescribed by the said *Act* recited Act,) all the rights and capacities within the said Colony of New South Wales, of a natural born British Subject, except the capacity of being a Member of either the Executive or Legislative Council.
